From there I played a season with the East Kilbride Pirates helping them get promoted to the Prem. I did have to cut that season short as I was given the opportunity to play in Australia with the Griffith Thunder in Brisbane helping set a culture in a brand-new team. With one of my best memories when beating our local rivals with very few players in the height of the Australian summer. After coming back to the UK I played two seasons in Aberdeen gaining my first Captaincy for the Bulls.

I first got involved with football when Ross asked me to give it a go during our rugby off season. For me there was no prior knowledge or love for the sport, just a desire to fill my time with another team sport while rugby wasn't available. Whilst I enjoyed playing for the Wolves Juniors and the combined youth team Forth Valley Fusion, it was my first year playing at Glasgow University that solidified American Football as the sport for me. I quickly left behind the notion that rugby was still for me and fully embraced this new sport playing as much and as often as I could. The four years of playing Tigers in the winter then Wolves in the summer were a lot of fun, albeit the harsh conditions of the 2G Astroturff at Garscube (best field in University Football) definitely took years off my knees and elbows, it gave me the opportunity to play with and against close friends for both teams.

After graduating in 2013 I couldn't leave University Football behind, volunteering to coach the Offensive Line for Edinburgh University Predators (now Mavericks).
